

## EADPH TRAVEL GRANT GUIDELINES

Delegates submitting an abstract on any topic relevant to dental public health for presentation at the annual EADPH congress may apply for a travel grant.

Although you do not have to be a member of EADPH to submit an abstract, applicants for travel grants must be EADPH members. Delegates are only permitted to present one abstract. You may, however, be a co-author of other abstracts.

Abstracts must be submitted electronically via the abstract submission form on the EADPH website [www.eadph.org](http://www.eadph.org). Remember to click the box for a travel grant when submitting your abstract.

Note that delegates who wish to apply for a travel grant award must submit their abstracts by the early closing date (see the EADPH website for details).

Up to 10 travel awards of €500 each have been awarded by The Borrow Foundation and 5 travel awards of €500 each have been awarded by GABA International.

Conditions for the travel grant;

- The applicant must submit an abstract before the early closing date (typically 2 months before the abstract deadline).
- The submission of an abstract carries with it the obligation to register and present at the conference.
- The conference registration fee and any other costs incurred will be deducted from the €500 travel grant of successful applicants.
- The balance of the travel grant will be paid to successful applicants at the annual congress.
- Priority will be given to researchers whose first degree was obtained in the last 10 years.
- Priority will be given to applicants from developing countries (World Bank definition, low and middle income countries).
- Priority is given to those who have not received a grant in the last 3 years.
- Abstracts received after the early closing date will not be eligible for a grant.
- Applicants living in the country hosting the annual congress are not eligible to apply for a travel grant.

The decision of the Abstract Reviewing Committee is final in deciding who will receive travel grants.
